CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

West End/Segment C: Traffic Diversion and Detour at National Blvd

Attention Residents and Business Owners

As part of the construction of the Expo Line project, work crews will **temporarily divert and detour traffic on National Boulevard for construction of the Venice/Robertson aerial structure**. The work is being managed by the Expo Construction Authority and performed by the general contractor *Balfour Beatty Infrastructure (BBI)*, and its subcontractors.

Traffic Diversion

When: Tuesday, July 6 to Saturday, July 31, 2010

Monday—Friday - 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM

Saturdays - 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM

Sundays - 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM

Where: National Blvd, between Washington Blvd and Wesley St, with traffic impacted from Wesley St to Venice Blvd

Traffic Impacts:

- **Westbound traffic** will be narrowed to a single lane and diverted around construction zone
- **Eastbound traffic** will be narrowed to a single lane
- **Pedestrian traffic** will continue to be diverted to the existing National Blvd pedestrian detour
- **Flagmen and directional signage** will be used to safely direct drivers and pedestrians around the construction zones in order to minimize the disruption to traffic

Traffic Detour - Eastbound National Blvd

When: July 10 and July 11, 2010

(Weekend Work Only)

Saturday - 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM

Sunday - 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM

Where: Eastbound National Blvd between Washington Blvd and Wesley St

Traffic Impacts:

- **Westbound traffic** will not be affected
- **Eastbound National Blvd** will be closed, and traffic will be detoured to Washington Blvd, to La Cienega Blvd, and back to Jefferson Blvd
- **Pedestrian traffic** will continue to be diverted to the existing National Blvd pedestrian detour
- **Flagmen and directional signage** will be used to safely direct drivers and pedestrians around the construction zones in order to minimize the disruption to traffic

Advisories:

Parking restrictions in all construction areas will be strictly enforced at all times. Please do not enter the construction work zone and obey all posted construction signs.

(Construction schedules are subject to change for various reasons including but not limited to: weather conditions, unforeseen emergencies and other acts of nature.)
