3			What is the Authority's view of the types of services that would be performed by the public affairs contractor under this procurement and any public affairs subcontractor that would be part of a team under the proposed design-build procurement?	The services are described in the RFP. No information about the scope of services to be performed by design-build team may be released in advance of the solicitation
4			If a consultant were to bid on and eventually be selected as part of this procurement would that consultant be precluded from being part of a design-build procurement team?	The consultant would be precluded because they could not work for the Authority under this solicitation and at the same time work for the design build contractor.
