QUESTION	RESPONSE
1. Will EMLCA (Expo) be paying for the conduit installation and fiber replacement?	<i>It depends on the provisions of any existing license agreement. It also depends on the company. For example, TWC is interested in new conduit for possible future facilities and would pay for their share of the project.</i>
2. If a communications company has an existing license agreement for crossing the RR right-of-way, aerially, will EMLCA (Expo) be picking up their costs to relocate?	<i>Relocation costs will be per the license agreement provisions and any other rights.</i>
3. If there isn't a crossing license agreement with EMLCA (Expo) in place, will each company need to obtain one?	<i>Metro Real Estate will handle any license agreement issues, including determining whether an agreement is needed.</i>
4. Who will be responsible for researching existing crossing agreement rights?	<i>Expo.</i>
5. Who will be paying the permit fees for encroachment permits, lane closure permits and any street use permits etc.?	<i>This depends on the license agreement and/or rights of the facility.</i>
6. Will EMLCA (Expo) be reimbursing the costs of PE stamps for TCP's, Caltrans and City of L. A. substructure plans if required?	<i>Please include as part of the fixed fee. See Addendum No.3</i>
7. Will wind load calculations be required on the new riser poles?	<i>This should be coordinated with DWP PS for any changes on their poles.</i>
8. Should we list TCP pricing as a separate engineering cost item?	<i>Yes.</i>
