The Exposition Metro Line Construction Authority (Authority) is seeking Bids for the Culver City Station Parking Lot Improvements.

Pre-Bid Conference

A Pre-bid Conference will be held at 10:00am on November 7, 2012 at Culver City Station Parking Lot located at 8804 W. Washington Blvd., Culver City, CA 90232 at Venice/Robertson SE Corner and Washington/National NW Corner.

Bid Due Date

Sealed bids must be received at the offices of the Authority no later than 2pm on Wednesday, November 28, 2012. Offers received after this date and time will not be accepted. The Authority will conduct a Public Bid Opening immediately following the receipt of bids.

Bid Guarantee

A Bid Guarantee of ten percent (10%) is required for submittal.

License Requirement

Bidders must possess a valid Class "A" General Engineering California Contractor's License at the time of Bid Opening. All listed Subcontractors must also possess a valid California Contractor's License for the type of work to be performed at the time of Bid Opening.

DBE Goal

The Contractor must meet a DBE goal of 10% for this work or demonstrate good faith efforts to meet this goal.

It is the policy of the Authority to ensure that DBEs can fairly compete for and perform on all Authority contracts and subcontracts. Accordingly, the Authority has adopted an overall DBE participation policy. All Bidders are encouraged to take all necessary and reasonable efforts to support of the objectives of the Authority's DBE Policy.

Prevailing Wages

Payment of prevailing wages and compliance with all required employment and training programs established by the Davis Bacon Act is required.


Non-Discrimination
