



Expo Phase 2 SkanskaRados Joint Venture (SRJV) Local Hire Program

Project Description

The Expo Light Rail Line Phase 2 project will extend the current Expo Line 6.6 miles from the Culver City Station to Santa Monica. It is expected to be completed in 2015. Pre-construction activities have been underway since late last year. Major construction is expected to begin in summer 2012 and continue through June 2014.



Program Overview

- The Exposition Construction Authority and its design-build contractor for Phase 2, Skanska-Rados Joint Venture (SRJV) are committed to providing opportunities for local residents and disadvantaged workers to enter into construction trade careers by working on the construction of the Expo Line Phase 2 project.
- The Exposition Construction Authority has set a goal that local and community area residents work **30%** of all construction craft hours on the project, including a 10% goal for disadvantaged workers.

Requirements

- The 30% local hire goal includes community area residents, local residents and disadvantaged workers:
 - **Community Area Residents:** Those who live within a 5-mile radius of the alignment between downtown Los Angeles and Santa Monica. To view list of zip codes, please click [here](#).
 - **Local Residents:** Those who live within Los Angeles County in specific areas with high unemployment. To view list of zip codes, please click [here](#).
 - **Disadvantaged Workers:** Those below a certain household income or who meet other criteria, such as being homeless, a single parent or receiving public assistance.
